Dear Mr McKean

The Select Committee on Ethics acknowledges receipt of your email of 11 March 2014 and advises that it considered your correspondence at its meeting yesterday.

The Committee noted the requests contained in your email:

- 1. I request to know the identity of the persons, other than Dr Levy, who need to be afforded procedural fairness in the course of the inquiry.*
- 2. To ensure interested parties are in the best position to make submissions to your inquiry, I request particulars of any documents under consideration by the Committee beyond those I have already identified, and for copies of those documents to be published.*

As you are aware, the Committee was established by motion of the House to investigate and report on matters relating to Dr Ken Levy's evidence to the PCMC.

In the course of its investigation the Committee has sought additional information from relevant persons but has determined that it will not be seeking submissions from interested members of the public, as it is considered unlikely that persons who have had no direct involvement with the matter would be in a position to add value to the Committee's deliberations.

Whilst we will not be seeking public submissions, the Committee does however appreciate your continuing interest in its work and will notify you by email once its report is tabled.
