

Managing Partner King & Wood Mallesons Australia Steps Down

King & Wood Mallesons confirmed today that Tony O'Malley, the Managing Partner of its Australian offices, had agreed to step down from his role effective immediately and will retire as a partner of the firm on 31 December this year.

Global Managing Partner, Stuart Fuller, said: "Tony has made a significant contribution to the firm for over 13 years, seven of which were in senior leadership roles. The Board and I would like to thank him for the valuable role he has played in the formulation, development and implementation of the firm's strategy.

Mr Fuller said a Board sub-committee had been formed to appoint a new Australian managing partner and that Mr O'Malley would assist in a smooth transition.

Said Mr Fuller: "The Board has started the process of appointing a new Managing Partner Australia and expects to make an announcement within the next two to three weeks.

"In the interim I will work closely with managing partners, executive directors, under the supervision of the Board, to ensure it is business as usual until a new managing partner Australia has been appointed."
